THE OCTAVE OF EASTER

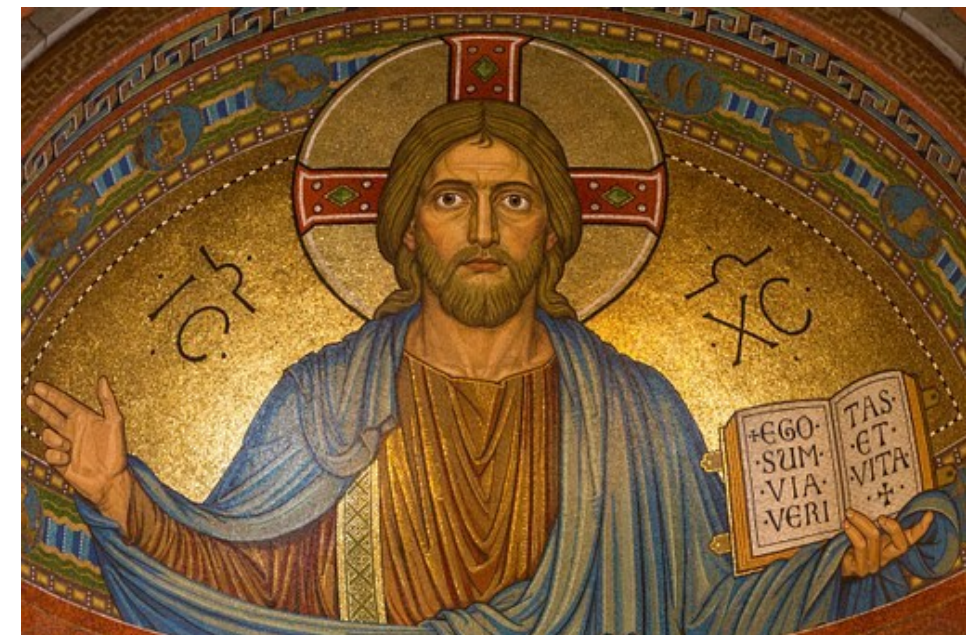
EASTER SUNDAY
