In Luke, as Jesus journeys to Jerusalem, he tells parables not found in other gospels, like today's well-known Good Samaritan passage. Each parable is told for a reason; this one because a lawyer wanted to justify himself regarding the law about loving neighbour as self. Or perhaps he wants to justify whom he excludes from his list! According to Jesus, a neighbour is anyone in need, and anyone who addresses the need of another. Self-justification is allowed!

St Bonaventure (1221-74) was baptised Joh. St Francis of Assisi was credited with curing him from a serious illness while still a child, and so his mother nicknamed in "Buona Ventura". He joined the Franciscans and, aged 35, he was elected Minister General or superior of the Franciscans. He provided them with a good structure for running their affairs and a clear spirituality based on the sayings of St Francis. He wrote many works on philosophy and theology, intertwining the two. Among theologians he is called the Seraphic Doctor.
