Two short parables liken our desire for the kingdom of heaven to someone who finds a treasure in a field, or a merchant who finds a pearl of great value. Both work hard to acquire what they value. The dragnet resembles the earlier parable of the weeds, but the dragnet adds another dimension: the boat must be rowed to produce a catch. Disciples are to harvest souls: only God may judge good from bad.
