
# BOOK CLUB

## **4TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)**

#### SATURDAY 28TH JANUARY

An easily recognisable feature of Matthew's gospel is Jesus' authentic teaching. Matthew presents five blocks of teaching, and this is from the first extract and most famous of these: the Sermon on the Mount. Moses had climbed Mount Sinai to receive God's Law, God's teaching. Jesus climbs the Galilean mountain (hill) to teach the true meaning of God's Law. Through the beatitudes in today's Gospel, he summarises to whom the kingdom of God belongs.
