#### LENT AND HOLY WEEK 2025

A Lenten service of the Word and Holy Communion will be celebrated by Deacon Christopher at St Anthony's Primary this Thursday morning at 8.30am; and on Friday morning at 8.30am at St Mark's Primary. This service is open to all parishioners. Stations of the Cross will be celebrated on a Tuesday evening at 6.30pm at St Anthony's. Last week's Stations were led by Paul May, our trainee deacon; this week (1st April) by the Alpha/RCIA Team; and next week (8th April) by the SSVP. A Holy Hour is held on Fridays from 4-5 pm at St Mark's, with silence, reflections, Sacrament of Reconciliation and Benediction. This is a beautiful and meditative way to start the weekend, and already the numbers are growing as word spreads. The Triduum services during HOLY WEEK will be as follows: Holy Thursday: Mass of the Lord's Supper 7pm at St Anthony's Good Friday: Children's Stations of the Cross 12 noon at St Anthony's Good Friday: Commemoration of the Lord's Passion and Veneration of the Cross 3pm at St Mark's Good Friday: Stations of the Cross and Veneration of the Cross 7pm at St Anthony's Holy Saturday: Easter Vigil 9pm at St Mark's (with 6 Baptisms) Easter Sunday: Mass 10am at St Mark's and 11.30am at St Anthony's. No evening Mass.

#### RCIA UPDATE

On the First Sunday of Lent our 4 parish catechumens - Alison, Carrie, Kirsten and Stephen - were enrolled along with 70 others from across the Diocese of Motherwell in the Book of the Elect at the Cathedral. Last Sunday evening at the 5pm Mass at St Anthony's they undertook the Scrutinies, the next step on their Lenten journey to Baptism at the Easter Vigil. This Saturday evening at the 5pm Vigil Mass at St Mark's, they will officially be presented with the Creed, which we will pray with them. This is given as a symbolic gift of the precious faith with they are soon to adopt through the Sacraments of Initiation. Carrie's daughters Willow and Quinn will also be baptised at the Easter Vigil, and are preparing for Baptism in school at St Mark's. Please keep them all in your prayers.

#### PENITENTIAL SERVICE WEDNESDAY 9TH APRIL

One of the five precepts of the Church which are binding on all Catholics is that we should confess our sins once per year in the Sacrament of Reconciliation (the other precepts are: Attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation.; Receive the Eucharist at least during the Easter season; Observe days of fasting and abstinence; and Contribute to the material needs of the Church). Catholics are also invited in a special way this year to receive God's forgiveness as an aspect of the celebration of the Holy Year. There are many opportunities to fulfil this precept during Lent (see Confession times on the front of the bulletin), but to help focus our minds, we'll have an hour dedicated to the Sacrament on **Wednesday 9th April from 7-8pm** at St Mark's. You can come along at any point and there will be visiting priests available as well as Fr Stephen, accompanied by exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.
