ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL UPDATE

A final vote is expected on this bill in the Scottish Parliament in March, so time is of the essence. You may have heard on the news that the bill is likely to be presented without conscience safeguards for medical professionals, yet another reason for the bill to be voted down and a more measured debate to ensue. You may also have seen in the news that several MSPs who voted for the bill at the first vote have changed their mind and now oppose it due to the weaknesses of the bill.

All are invited, especially the Religious of the Diocese, and priests are welcome to concelebrate.
